




Begin by removing folded easel (A) from bag (B). You will also find an adjustable canvas support (C), alongside a pressure bar strapped around the easel.



Open tripod legs and make sure it is stable on its three feet.





Secure the adjustable canvas support (C) by placing over bolts and slotting them into the holes. This will help to ensure that your easel is stable.






Unscrew top clamp from its bar.



Slide bottom clamp (D) into the top of the bar and move all the way down. Adjust to match the size of your surface and then screw back the top clamp.



Adjust and tighten the main wheel to find the good inclination for your surface.



Place your canvas/surface and tighten the top clamp to secure its position. And now, paint away!
