The history and use of colored pencils MONDELUZ

Mondeluz Aquarelle Colored Pencils marry the traditions of watercolor paint and colored pencil. Both mediums have rich histories in the art world. Egyptian scrolls, Asian silks, and the hand colored documentation of the "new world" have all been touched by watercolor. The colored pencil, while notably a more modern invention, has also made contributions in art. Such artists as Toulouse-Lautrec, Henri Matisse and Pablo Picasso have used the colored pencil as a device for creation and experimentation with great success. While the watercolor pencil is not a new device, Koh-I-Noor has improved the quality of this medium in the Mondeluz Aquarelle Colored Pencil, resulting in one of the best professional grade watercolor pencils in the world.

Koh-l-Noor expands on tradition by presenting a colored pencil that can either be used alone or with water to create the effects of these two media. The Mondeluz Aquarelle Colored Pencil lead is soft and vibrant, consisting of water-soluble pigments. The effect is dense color that lays down beautifully and easily. Water may be added by brushing over the hand drawn strokes to soften and blur the lines, creating a watercolor paint effect. With this medium the precision of the colored pencil and the delicacy of watercolor can create a stunning effect.

The number of techniques used with the Mondeluz Aquarelles are only limited to the artist's imagination. These pencils can be used on a multitude of surfaces, such as vellum, canvas and watercolor paper. They can be used wet or dry, over a dry surface or a wash. Mondeluz Aquarelles can also be used with other media such as traditional watercolor, graphite, pastel, ink and acrylic paint. The versatility of the Mondeluz Aquarelle makes this one of the most sought-after watercolor pencils for artists and illustrators today.

Characteristics:

Koh-I-Noor spans the globe in search of rich, top quality pigments for their Mondeluz Aquarelle Colored Pencils. These pigments are highly concentrated and perfectly dispersed throughout the entire Mondeluz color range. Mondeluz Aquarelles also maintain excellent light permanency, creating vibrant, durable pieces of art.

Another key component of the Mondeluz Aquarelle Colored Pencil is the use of the highest quality bleached kaolin white clay. This clay gives these colored pencils an unsurpassable ability to make dense strokes that lay down beautifully on many surfaces. The finest binders and additives are also combined into this unique formula to ensure excellent solubility of all components. The 3.8 mm diameter lead is encased in California Cedar for easy sharpening. The final product is non-toxic and therefore suitable for all ages.

There are countless techniques to achieve a watercolor appearance with Mondeluz Aquarelles. One of the most common methods is to apply dry strokes to a surface before going over the drawing with a wet brush. Another technique is to apply a wet brush to the pencil lead, then painting directly with the loaded brush. These pencils can also be dipped in water and used wet onto watercolor paper or other surfaces. Shaved pencil chips or dust can be used as well; once applied and diluted with water a unique watercolor effect can be achieved. The possibilities are only limited by one's imagination.
