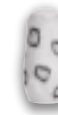

From biggest to littlest, give these pets personality with paint and rub-on sticker accents.



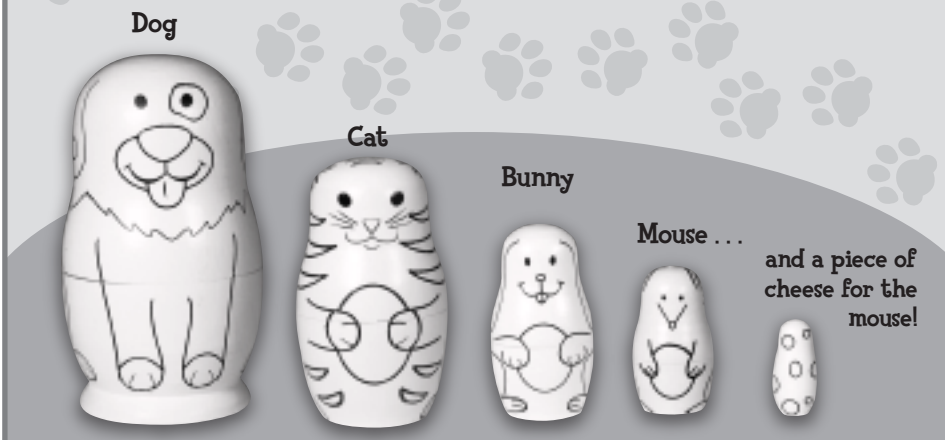
Getting Started

- The paint included is a specially formulated non-toxic, acrylic paint that dries permanently on most surfaces, so be careful.
- Cover your work surface with newspaper. Have a cup of water and paper towels handy.
- Wear a smock or old clothes. This paint may stain fabrics and furniture. Clean up any spills immediately while the paint is still wet.
- Paint can settle and separate over time. Mix each color thoroughly before you begin painting. If the paint seems too thick, stir in a drop or two of water.
- Before changing colors, rinse and dry your brush thoroughly.

Natural wood products may be effected by changes in heat and humidity. If the dolls are difficult to open or close, ask an adult to help you. A firm twist or a slight tap on the table may be necessary. Use your sand paper to smooth any rough edges.

Let's Get Ready to Paint

Your nesting doll set includes 4 animals



Your nesting dolls are printed with a painting pattern to follow. Use the black marker included to add additional designs, or to go over your design after the paint has dried.

Your set includes two paint brushes. -The smaller one for fine detail and the bigger one to paint larger areas. Look at the pictures on the box for ideas or inspiration.

Painting Tips

- For best results, separate the animal pieces when painting. Paint a small portion at a time.
- Do not paint the bottom edges where the dolls fit together. If you get paint in this area, immediately wipe it off or your doll may not fit together properly.
- When painting, you can hold them in your hand, or place them on the table to paint.
- Remember, paint one portion at a time, letting it dry before moving on to the next section.
- When you paint, match up the colors on the top and bottom of your animal. Or be creative and make crazy mixed up animals.

- You can also mix the paint included to create new colors. Here are some suggestions:

Black + White = Gray

Red + Blue = Purple

Red + white = Pink

Blue + White = Light Blue

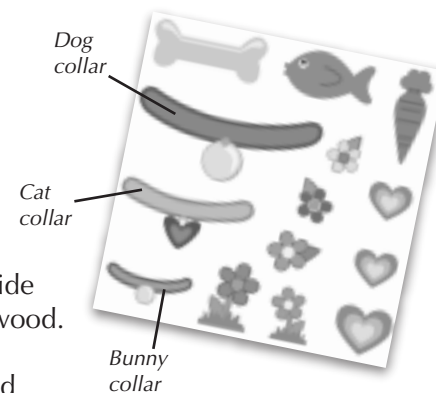
Orange + Yellow = Yellow- Orange

- Create different shades of brown by adding a little white paint, a little black paint, or a little red paint.
- When the paint has dried, you can add a second coat as desired.

Rub -off Stickers

Once your paint is completely dry, add the rub off designs. These are sized to match the animals. If you are not sure which go together, refer to the pictures on the box.

- Cut around the rub off you want to use. Place it on the animal, clear side facing up, printed side touching the wood.
- Take the end of your black marker and rub it evenly over the back of the design.
- Carefully pull up one corner of the sheet. If the design is not completely attached to the animal, push it back down and continue rubbing.



Finishing Touches

Personalization Sticker- Add your name to the round sticker and place it on the bottom of your largest nesting doll.

You can display them individually or all stacked together. -It's up to you. Don't forget to give each of your pets a name - You can even name the cheese if you like!

History of the Nesting Doll

The original nesting dolls were first crafted in Russia. These sets were known as Matryoshka dolls. The word "Matryoshka" was a popular Russian name derived from the word "mother". Today many people collect Matryoshka dolls. They can be found in endless shapes, sizes and themes.
